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

#### Weingut Egon Müller

Founded in 1797 in the Saar district of the Mosel region, Egon Müller produces some of the world's finest Rieslings, with aging potentials that are easier measured in decades than years, and prices that rival any of the world's most prestigious wineries. Egon Müller IV is the current winemaker and owner of Weingut Egon Müller. Born in August 1959, he is the fourth Egon Müller in the weingut's (winery's) history. He is also the sixth generation of the family to own and run the estate, after his great-great-grandfather Jean-Jacques Koch bought it from the French Republic at the end of the 18th century. He also has a son named Egon.

Weingut Egon Müller produces wines using only one grape variety, Riesling. But it manages to release a number of different bottlings every year by harvesting grapes at different times, and vinifying them to a range of different sweetness levels, from off-dry kabinett to the sumptuously sweet trockenbeerenauslese. The latter style, along with the winery's beerenauslese release, is dependent on vintage conditions being suitable for Botrytis cinerea (noble rot) to infect grapes without turning them moldy. Egon Müller produces Riesling in multiple countries. In Slovakia, Egon Müller IV collaborates with Miroslav Petrech to make topclass Riesling under the Château Belá label. And in the Adelaide Hills of Australia, he also works with Michael Andrewarta of East End Cellars to release a dry Riesling called Kanta.







# Germany

Egon Müller owns 21 acres of the 70-acre Scharzhofberger, one of the world's best Riesling vineyards. It's located in Wiltingen, on the Saar river, on a slate-rich, south-facing slope. Classified as an ortsteil ("district"), the Scharzhofberger name can be used on the labels of wines made there, much like the grand cru sites of Burgundy.

Egon Müller ferments and ages its wines in thousand-liter old oak foeders (casks), as is traditional in the Mosel region. Where possible, the winery uses only indigenous yeasts for fermentation. This almost always means that not all the sugar in the must is converted to alcohol, but the naturally high acidity of the Riesling grape balances out any residual sweetness in the final wines.

In a wide-ranging interview with Enology International's Jordan P. Ross, Egon Müller IV described 1987 as "the last bad year" his winery experienced. Despite this, he said that the ancient vines and slate-rich soils of the Scharzhofberger vineyard still provided "very flavorful wines" that year.

This is the third edition from the Bowmore 50-Year-Old Vaults Series. The liquid in this remarkably rare limited-edition bottling was some of the first to pass through Bowmore's then-new steam heated stills in 1965. The extended maturation period has created a rare and refined whisky with the perfect blend of complexity and elegance, exemplifying Bowmore's history spent perfecting the art of whisky maturation. This expression is a rich reward for those who value the importance of savouring time.

# Languedoc

#### Domaine de La Grange Des Pères

How many winemakers in the south of France can claim to be amongst France's greatest? Laurent Vaillé is definitely one of them - attaining his "cult wine" status where the odds were all against him. He started his career training in the cellars with Jean Francois Coche-Dury (Meursault), Gérald Chave (Hermitage), and Eloi Durrbach (Domaine de Trévallon, Provence), before settling in the l'Hérault of the Langedoc where he purchased his first vineyards in 1989. The Vaillé family is deeply attached to their Aniane's terroir, and they know exactly how to unlock its full potential by constant work in the vineyards and keeping low yields (20-25 hl/ha). The total production is tiny (2,500-3,000 cases annually). His choice seemed at the beginning a bit odd; because the nature of the poor, hard limestone soil, which required massive work in order to enable planting vines on them at all. But soon after, it became clear that he actually discovered a great and very unique terroir under these hard rocks. Choosing the right clones was obvious to him. He sourced his Syrah, Marsanne, and Roussane cuttings from Gérard Chave, His Chardonay from Coche-Dury and his Cabernet from Domaine de Trévallon. The result is no less than what is widely considered as one of the greatest wines in France. He constantly achieves the very difficult harmony between power, freshness, delicacy and a long-lasting taste.

#### Amarone della Valpolicella 'Vigneto Monte Lodoletta'

At the age of 22, Romano Dal Forno first met Giuseppe Quintarelli, who introduced him to a new way of growing vines and producing wine, based on quality rather than quantity. Since then, by investing in his own vineyards and overcoming the initial difficulties, Romano has managed, thanks also to the precious contribution of his sons Marco, Luca and Michele, to get his company to the first-rate positions in international wine. Since the early 1980s, and exactly since the 1983 season, harvest after harvest, Amarone della Valpolicella and Valpolicella DOC, labeled "Dal Forno Romano", have always placed themselves at the top of excellence.

An obsessive attention is paid to all production processes, both between the rows and in the cellar, starting from the planting of the vineyards to get to the drying techniques. In the vineyard, after years and years of experimentation, today the agronomic methods followed are precise and scrupulous, as well as the drying techniques for the production of Amarone have been put in place with attention to every little and smallest detail. In the cellar, taking advantage of a structure built during the last decade of the last century, the most ancient territorial traditions are never outclassed. This is how, in the Val d'Illasi, just east of Verona, the more than twelve hectares of vineyards owned, to which are added another twelve hectares for rent, from which come to life labels that have represented for years the excellence of a entire region, symbolizing at the same time the emblem of the superb quality that every great wine producer should aim to achieve. From Valpolicella Superiore to Amarone della Valpolicella, from Vigna Seré up to Monte Lodoletta, they are all wines, those branded "Romano Dal Forno", which for some time now have held the flag of the best "made in Italy" high when it comes to wine.

#### Bolgheri Superiore 'Vendemmia 30'

Much has been said about the other Super Tuscan in Bolgheri - Sassicaia, fêted by critics, adored by celebrities and sought after by collectors. Not much has been said about its close second, Grattamacco, the second winery set up in Italy's coastal Bolgheri and a true champion of Bolgheri. Located on top of a hill facing the Tyrrhenian Sea between Castagneto Carducci and Bolgheri, the winery was founded by Piermario Meletti Cavallari, an adventurous entrepreneur who followed Mario Incisa della Rocchetta's footsteps to the maremma coast where in 1977 Grattamacco was founded in the DOC area of Bolgheri where the growing of Cabernet Sauvignon in this particular region gained great popularity. The first vintage produced was 1982 by blending Cabernet Sauvignon with Merlot and Sangiovese. The estate is situated on top of the hill, facing the sea between Castagneto Carducci and Bolgheri at 100 meter above sea level. The area is particularly dedicated to the production of great wines and enjoys a dry climate with consistent thermal excursions at the end of the summer. The estate extends over an area of about 50 hectares, of which 25 are vineyards and 5 are olive groves. The remaining area is forest and borders into a vast area of woodlands covering some 1,600 hectares. The estate follows the criteria of organic farming, guaranteed and certified by ICEA.

Only the best vintages give life to the Barolo Riserva Sette7anni, made with grapes from the most important vineyards, Bussia, Panerole and Pugnane, located respectively in Monforte d'Alba, Novello and Castiglione Falletto. Franco Conterno is always one of the last to harvest so that, in addition to beautiful ripe fruit, to avoid annoying tannins from the stems. Temperature controlled fermentation and then maturation in large French wooden barrels for 7 (!) Years. Vibrant grenade red colour with light orange notes; rich and complex nose; coarse, powerful and tannic flavour.

### Domaine des Comtes Lafon

The origin of the domaine's name is far from Burgundian, and can be traced back to the Lafons of south-west France. It was actually a family named Boch that in 1894 Jules Joseph Barthélémy Lafon married into, and with his new wife, Marie, came a wine merchants business and small estate in Meursault which is still home to the domaine today. Jules was eventually to become the Mayor of Meursault, at that time reviving an old tradition; the celebration with a meal of the end of the harvest – this gained a momentum of its own, finally becoming the banquet we know today, named the 'Paulée de Meursault'.

# Burgundy

The next generation of Lafon were not involved with the domaine, and the vines were put out to share-croppers. Indeed it is said that if the grandson of Jules. René Lafon, had not been against it, his father Henri might have sold the whole estate. René took over the estate in 1956 and with the share-croppers help set about improving and replanting the vines, and began estate bottling - for the first time in 1961 they bottled everything. Dominique Lafon is the current face of the domaine, He took-over from René in 1984, together with his brother Bruno, who has since faded into the background. Dominique was one of the fêted 'new generation' of young owner managers; he set about recovering all the domaine's vines as metayage contracts came to an end, and was one of the more 'visible' producers that were shying away from 'chemical' treatments in the vines - for instance turning away from herbicides in 1992.

# Burgundy

### Domaine Lucie et Auguste Lignier

Domaine Lucie et Auguste Lignier covers a total of 8.3 hectares. The portfolio holds the whole spectrum of wines, from regional appellations such as Bourgogne, Bourgogne Aligoté, Bourgogne Passetoutgrain all the way up to the two grands crus of the domaine, the Clos de la Roche and the Charmes-Chambertin. There are wines from the village appellations in Morey-Saint-Denis (Les Sionnières), Gevrey-Chambertin (Les Seuvrées), Chambolle-Musigny (Les Bussières) and Fixin (Champs de Vosger). The premiers crus are distributed in a similar manner - Les Baudes in Chambolle-Musigny, Aux Combottes in Gevrey-Chambertin and Les Chaffots in Morey-Saint-Denis. Then there is the Morey-Saint-Denis 1er Cru "Cuvée Romain Lignier". Originally this was a blend of two parcels, "Les Faconnieres" and "Les Cheneveries", but in 2007 Kellen decided to stop bottling the premier cru "La Riotte" on its own and include it in the Romain Lignier blend instead. As it usually is, the Clos de Roche is aromatically less expressive than the Charmes and Combottes at present with much more deeply pitched and cooler red berry fruit aromas that are liberally laced with soil and mineral tones that dissolve into tautly muscled, rich, full and solidly powerful flavors that possess excellent length and a real sense of underlying tension.

### Bodegas Alión in Padilla de Duero

The first vintage of the Alión was vinified in 1991, but it was not until 1996 that a qualitative breakthrough was achieved. In retrospect, the 1994 and 1995 cohorts have already developed tremendously, which was probably seen differently at the time. Since the 1999 vintage at the latest, Alión has been producing high-quality wines with impressive constancy. The motivation for setting up a new bodega for Vega Sicilia was the desire to produce single-variety Tempranillo wines of a more modern style, which would not have been easily possible at Vega Sicilia. Xavier Ausas has been the Group's chief oenologist since 1998.

# **Sweet Wines**

### Sauternes de Château d'Yquem: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6

'Sauternes' has a specific objective: "We want people to enjoy it, in a relaxed way. We subscribe to the idea of modernising consumption of Sauternes wines", explains Sandrine Garbay. The winemaker goes on to explain how she created the blend "of grape varieties, vineyard sites and vintages. On average, 4 to 5 years are blended, including the latest vintage, akin to a solera, with a set base to which a recent vintage is added". Each new bottling has a different number, creating a timeline for this unique, non-vintage wine.

It is designed to be enjoyed as an aperitif and accessibility is key to the way it was crafted. Its inception dates back to 2005, when Pierre Lurton took over at the helm of Château d'Yquem. After tasting batches of wines deemed unsuitable for producing the celebrated noble-rot wine and subsequently sold in bulk, he decided to give some of them to the estate's employees. As climate change has increased ripeness levels during the sorting process, production has grown and the amount of wine offloaded in bulk has risen to an average of 50%. "It was a shame that all of it should be shipped in bulk. In 2014, Sauternes 1 was launched for employees of the LVMH group", points out Sandrine Garbay.





### **Sweet Wines**



Faced with sustained demand from LVMH employee groups, Château d'Yquem is now going all the way and serving Sauternes 6 to chateau visitors. For its public release, the collection of Sauternes 1 to 6 is sold in a mixed. "Quantities are limited, but if it sells well, we will be able to make more", says Sandrine Garbay, who so far has only mentioned cellar door sales. Each edition of Sauternes de Château d'Yquem is made from a blend of vintages. To the base vintage, proportions of other vintages are added gradually.







# Premier Grand Cru Bordeaux

Pauillac, 1<sup>er</sup> Grand Cru Classé Excellent level & appearance

A sensational effort, the 2006 Mouton Rothschild exhibits an opaque purple color as well as a classic Mouton perfume of creme de cassis, flowers, blueberries, and only a hint of oak. Dalhuin told me that in whisky barrel-tasting vintages such as 1989 and 1990, Mouton was aged in heavily-toasted barrels, and they have backed off to a much lighter toast for the barrels' interior. I think this has worked fabulously well with the cassis quality fruit they get from their Cabernet Sauvignon. The fullbodied, powerful 2006 possesses extraordinary purity and clarity. A large-scaled, massive Mouton Rothschild that ranks as one of the top four or five wines of the vintage, it may turn out to be the longest-lived wine of the vintage by a landslide. The label will undoubtedly be controversial as a relative of Sigmund Freud, Lucian Freud, has painted a rather comical Zebra staring aimlessly at what appears to be a palm tree in the middle of a stark courtyard. I suppose a psychiatrist could figure out the relationship between that artwork and wine, but I couldn't see one. This utterly profound Mouton will need to sleep for 15+ years before it will reveal any secondary nuances. but it is a packed and stacked first-growth Pauillac of enormous potential. Anticipated maturity: 2020-2060+. Robert Parker Jr. 97 points.

Tasted three weeks after bottling, I couldn't quite bring myself to give the elusive three-digit score to this admittedly super wine. Perhaps once the 2016 Chateauneuf du Pape Hommage à Jacques Perrin has been in bottle a bit longer, as Mourvèdre seems to go into a bit of a funk when recently bottled. For now, it's merely profound, packing in savory, mossy nuances, hints of exotic dried spices like star anise and cardamom and layers of rich, plummy fruit that manage to be full-bodied and deliciously intense without being weighty or overwrought. Creamy, lush, intense and long, it's a tdf (tour de force) in CdP. Wine Advocate, 99+ points.

But inspiration struck when the 7 Morinis tasted wine from neighbouring producer, Romano del Forno, and decided to turn the fruits of their labour into wine! This is deliciously modern Amarone, hand harvested and air dried for 100-120 days in traditional small baskets. Find fantastic fruitcake aromas, a rich, profound palate and superb, fleshy tannins and length.



A great vintage for mourvedre in 2017, it represents 60% of this blend. Picked late, at the beginning of October, this has a very rich, dark-stone, leather, grilled-meat and slate nose with black fruit and wild herbs. The palate has a rich, smooth and long core of noble tannin with a wealth of dark cherries and dark plums. Long, suave tannins command the finish, where there's a late kick of spice. Good potential, ripeness and concentration. As with the regular Beaucastel Châteauneuf, the intensity and plushness of tannin is a highlight here. Try from 2025. *James Suckling*, 97 points.
